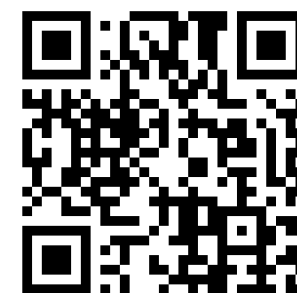
Step 2: Plan It

Why Fundraise for Butterwick Hospice?



When you raise funds for the hospice, you help us continue to provide specialist, holistic care to those in our community who need us.

Here are just a few examples of what the money you raise could provide for those who need us...

£100

could provide one session of Day Care for a Service User in our Day Care unit

£250

could provide one night of care from our Homecare Team for a service user in the comfort of their own home

£500

could provide one month of physiotherapy support

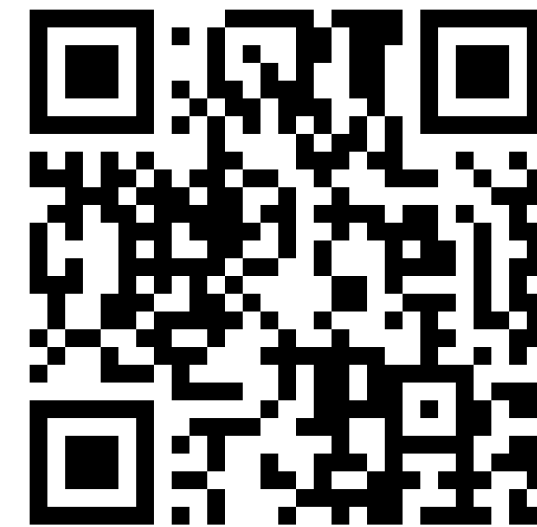
£1000

could provide one night of respite care for a child in our Children's Hospice

Don't forget to *giftaid it*

Gift Aid allows charities like us to claim 25p for every £1 that Tax Payers donate. That's a whole 25% on top of what you raise.

Make sure that when tax payers donate, they complete the Gift Aid declaration on your sponsor form and JustGiving page!

Can your employer match the funds you raise? Lots of employers will support their teams charitable activities by match-funding the amount they raise!

Things to Keep in Mind

However you choose to fundraise, it's really important that everything is safe and legal. Here's some things to keep in mind...

Raffles

Raffles are a brilliant way to raise funds, but make sure you're aware of the legalities beforehand. Find the latest guidance here [gamblingcommission.gov.uk](https://www.gamblingcommission.gov.uk)

Food Hygiene

Whether you're selling cupcakes or putting on a three-course dinner, food safety laws will apply. Check in with [food.gov.uk](https://www.food.gov.uk) to be on the safe side.

Insurance and Licensing

Although we're here to support you when you fundraise, we aren't responsible for your event and can't accept any liability. We recommend that you check with your local authority whether you need any special licences for your fundraising activity.
