A watershed moment came when Map Electrics was working for Mandale Properties on two apartment blocks where Comcast sought to install cable television. After much negotiation, Map was awarded the opportunity to install Comcast in all apartment blocks across Teesside.

Comcast went on to be taken over by NTL, which later merged with Telewest to form Virgin Media and Map Electrics continued to grow as a result. By the early 2000s, the company was employing 1,000 engineers, serving 5,000 customers a day with cable TV, telephony and the internet.

Map Electricals was rebranded as Map Group (UK) in 2008, Map House was built at Preston Farm, Stockton the same year and is located next door to Map's sister company, the Digital Telecoms Network Academy which provides accreditation and training across the telecommunications industry.


This year, our Children's Hospice is celebrating its 25th anniversary!

Educational Engagement Programme



As a charitable organisation, we always welcome opportunities where we can help support the local community, in addition to the care, love and services that we provide as a Hospice. We are proud to support local Academy Trusts, engaging with students aged from 10 years old through to college leavers at 18 years old, providing valuable educational experiences.

In June this year, we launched our first educational programme, and the engagement with the students was fantastic. We welcomed a local Stockton school, St Gregory's Catholic Academy. The Year 6 children came to the Hospice for an educational visit, which also gave us the opportunity to personally thank them for their amazing fundraising efforts during the Hospice's Royal Dash campaign.

Their visit was coordinated by Deputy Head Teacher, Mrs Wilson, and Teacher Mrs Taylor. In preparation for the visit the children had been learning, as part of their Religious Educational studies, about Hospice care and how we differ from a hospital. Prior to their visit, the children had also been learning about Butterwick Hospice and our founder Mary Butterwick, OBE.

It was wonderful to be able to support the education of the children, their enthusiasm to see the Hospice and the work we do was really inspiring. Our team led talks and answered any questions the students had following on from the research they had done prior to their visit.

Our Educational Programme continued throughout July, with our Chief Executive, Edward Gorringe, welcoming Year 10 students from the Nicholas Postgate Catholic Academy Trust for a series of Interactive Career Showcase Days. Director of Care, Allana Massingham and the Hospice Nursing Team, talked about their own career development within the Nursing profession and what it's like to work in a Hospice. Our Director of Income Generation, Anne Cooling, and the Income Generation Team, spoke about the importance of fundraising and our business models.

Additionally, we welcomed Year 12 students from the Postgate Trust over a two-week period for work experience. We offered support for students who are interested

Family Support

Our team of qualified, experienced Counsellors, understand that at certain points in our lives, we all need someone to turn to.

We all need support sometimes, and when we're grieving for a loved one, or faced with a life changing diagnosis, Butterwick Hospice has its arms open wide. The reassurance of knowing someone is there when you need support, can make the biggest difference of all.

Our Family Support team is here to do just that, they offer Counselling for pre and post bereavement, grief counselling and counselling for those who are facing a terminal diagnosis. We support children and adults through some of the darkest and emotionally traumatic times of their lives by delivering counselling services.

One of our Counsellors, Paula Thompson, shared her perspective on the impact and importance of the service, "I worked with a young teenager called Lauren*, whose Mam had recently died. In our first session as we were getting to know each other and building trust, Lauren shared with me that she liked to draw, so we decided we would draw together. As Lauren talked about her Mam, she began to draw her. Closing her eyes, she spoke about her Mam's hair and the smell of it, as she became more comfortable, she recalled her Mam's scent, her wonderful laugh, and how she gave the most amazing cuddles when you felt down, and all the other irreplaceable things Lauren missed about her, and knew she would never have again.

Lauren just wanted her Mam back, she was so devastated that she had gone, but felt unable to share her feelings at home, as Dad was hurting too, and she didn't want to add to his pain."

That's why the work our Family Support team does is so important. Our sessions give people a safe space to think, to express all their emotions and to be able to talk about the day their life changed forever. We offer Counselling services for individuals as well as host Bereavement Groups across both of our sites at Stockton and Bishop Auckland, with a focus on support for not just the patient impacted by a diagnosis, but the whole family.
