Mary Butterwick's Story



Mary Butterwick founded Butterwick Hospice in 1984, after her husband John died unexpectedly in 1979.

Mary was offered little support from the hospital, and was told to go home and forget about John.

Instead, Mary spent time in the community with others who had similar experiences, and decided there had to be a better option - she wanted to put back into the world some of the care she felt was lacking.

She designed a home, light and airy; a welcoming place where people felt safe and instantly comfortable. 'It was a place where people were treated as individuals, where each life mattered, where each thought mattered, where care and love mattered... For all those whom the hospital had dismissed as beyond help, it would restore hope, celebrate life and, even if it couldn't heal the body, it would do its best to heal the heart and soul.' - Carmel Thomason, Every Moment Counts: The Life of Mary Butterwick.

From that moment, Mary made it her mission to create this 'home', and in 1984, after selling her family home to kick start the funding she needed, Mary opened the first Day Care Hospice in Stockton. Mary and a small group of volunteer nurses and supporters delivered her recipe of loving care and compassion to those who were at the end of their life, and gave comfort and hope to their loved ones.

Forty years later, Mary's legacy has continued and we now offer care to babies, children and adults across Teesside and County Durham, as well as support for their families.


Can your employer match the funds you raise?


Lots of employers will support their teams charitable activities by match-funding the amount they raise!




Blue for Butterwick Run for Butterwick




Non Uniform Day

Here are just a few examples of what the money you raise could provide for those who need us...

could provide one night of care from our Home Care Team for a patient in the comfort of their own home

@ £500 @

could provide one month of Physiotherapy for a patient with chronic pain

@ £1000 @
